Emily Carr University of Art + Design is a world-renowned learning and research community located on unceded, traditional and ancestral x^wməθk^wəyəm (Musqueam), Sk̓wx̓wú7mesh Úxwumixw (Squamish), and səłilwətaʔ (Tsleil-Waututh) territories in Vancouver, Canada. It is the only post-secondary institution in British Columbia dedicated to the education and practice of art, media and design, and in 2020 it was ranked the top university in Canada for art and design by QS World University Rankings. ECU has a diverse student body that welcomes people from more than 50 countries. Each individual enriches our institution with their unique perspectives and practices. As part of our commitment to transformation and equality, we want to ensure that our faculty reflects the diversity of our exceptional students. To realize this goal, we are seeking five new faculty members to join Emily Carr. We recognize that members of Indigenous and racialized communities have been historically underrepresented at our university, as they have at many others. With approval from BC's Office of the Human Rights Commissioner, we are restricting this employment opportunity to candidates who identify as Indigenous or as a member of a racialized group.
